

Brixham Battery WW2 Museum



The emergency coastal battery built at Brixham in 1940 formed part of a line of defenses that spanned the coast of England.

This site in Brixham is one of the few remaining and best preserved in the country. Enjoy a guided tour of the building and explore the exhibits in the museum (both military and home front) and learn about the famous Home Guard and the role they played in keeping Brixham safe.

Have the chance to handle authentic original weapons and look inside the original wartime Anderson shelter.
