

Burgh Island Hotel



Burgh Island hotel is an iconic Art Deco landmark and retreat, positioned on a wildly beautiful and secluded tidal island. This sea hotel was once described as a shining white ocean liner surrounded by golden beaches and silver seas.

Originally built in 1929, it was extended in 1932 and now restored to its 1930s glamour.

Enjoy a one-hour walking history tour through the hotel, culminating in a cocktail demonstration.

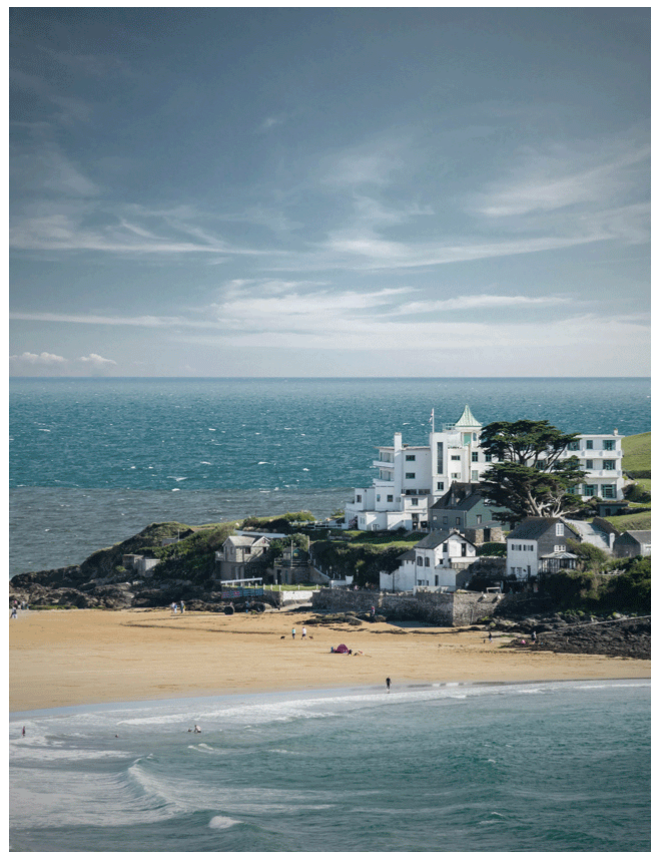




Guests can additionally book a table for popular afternoon tea or light bites before the tour.

Transport across the beach to the hotel can be provided by 4x4 vehicle or sea tractor when tide is in, subject to weather conditions.

- Private tours possible – up to 10 people.
- Walk/drive across the beach when the tide is out. Travel on the sea tractor when tide is in.



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
