

Canoe River Adventure



A half-day tour on a large 12 seat Canadian canoe, experiencing the tranquil beauty of the Dart Estuary, and with time on the foreshore.

Paddling, ice cream, firebuilding, catching crabs, tea, hot chocolate and laughter, all rolled into one great adventure. Proper, timeless, healthy fun to enjoy on the water and on the shore.





Guided by the canoe skipper, it will typically be a relaxed paddle up-river, with time ashore in the village of Dittisham, and on the foreshore somewhere only accessible by boat.

Here we chill out, build a fire, have a brew (provided), maybe play some games, catch some crabs and learn about the wildlife. The paddling is split up into three 20-50 minute sections.

The return to Dartmouth will normally be by ferry (depending on tides, this could be the outward trip).

- Zero Carbon Tour option & South Devon National Landscape tour.
- Possible for wheelchair users, using a hoist to board.
- Can also be run from landings in Stoke Gabriel, Dittisham or Tuckenhay, requiring a mini-bus or ferry transfer to/from Dartmouth, but allows more time in the most tranquil parts of the river



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
