

Murder & Wine



Agatha Christie's Greenway & Sandridge Barton Vineyard & Wine Tasting
A half-day tour to two of the great estates on the banks of the Dart.

The trip starts with a river cruise from Dartmouth to Greenway.

Queen of Crime, Agatha Christie's country estate at Greenway is a beautiful manor house on the edge of the River Dart. In the house and grounds you will see the inspiration for many of Christie's novels, as well as relics of the house's use as a headquarters of American forces in the build-up to D-Day.

Sandridge Barton is a 450 acre estate, whose owners have been crafting wines with soul on the banks of the Dart for over 40 years. You will get an insight into the winemaking process from vine to wine with a safari truck tour of the vineyard, a visit to the winery, followed by a guided tasting of three wines, paired with local cheese and plenty of good stories.
