

Rewilding the River Dart - Sharpham Estate



A half-day tour of one of the most historic estates on the River Dart, starting with a river cruise from Dartmouth to Sharpham.

Sharpham Estate dates back to the Domesday Book. Visit Sharpham House, built in 1765 and famous for its spiral staircase, to learn about the meditation retreats that are run at the house by The Sharpham Trust.

Walk around the estate and gardens learning about the heritage and history. Groups will also visit the Trust's rewilding project, which is restoring nature and biodiversity, and learn more about the project to restore the River Dart from its source high on Dartmoor all the way to Dartmouth.





Sharpham is not open to the public so this is an exclusive tour.

Travel from Dartmouth to Sharpham by ferry or minibus.

Tour of estate and house is three hours.

Can include meditation session of 30 minutes or longer.
