

Dartmouth Steam Railway & River Boat



1: Enjoy a full day excursion on steam train and river cruise

Travel on the steam railway between Kingswear and Paignton, then cross the River Dart on our foot passenger ferry back to Dartmouth, where you board one of our boats for a circular river cruise (approximately 1hr duration) around the river and estuary. The cruise takes you to the mouth of the river passing Kingswear & Dartmouth Castles, Dittisham village, Britannia Royal Naval College and Greenway House – home to the late Dame Agatha Christie.

2: Dartmouth to Totnes River Cruise (Return)

Sail nine miles on the beautiful River Dart between the delightful and unique towns of Dartmouth and Totnes. Enjoy the riverside villages of Stoke Gabriel and Dittisham and the steeply wooded hillsides plunging down to the water's edge, providing unparalleled scenic views.





The trip can be split e.g. only river cruise or only steam train return.

Both river cruise and steam train are accessible with wheelchairs
(excluding electric wheelchairs).

On the river cruise you can either return by boat or bus back to
the start point of Dartmouth.

There is a possibility to hire the steam train for exclusive use,
depending on time of year and timetable.



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
